Wagonway, LLC (“**Company**”, “**we**”, or “**us**”) provides this policy (“**Privacy Policy**”) to inform you about our policies and procedures regarding the collection, use, and disclosure of information through www.wagonway.com (the “**Website**”), including any functionality or related services offered on or through the Website. This Privacy Policy also governs the collection, use, and disclosure of information we may obtain outside the Website in connection with our services pursuant to any written agreement that links to this Privacy Policy.

Please read this Privacy Policy carefully as it describes your rights and options with respect to the use of your personal information. By accessing the Website or using any service provided by us, you consent to the information collection, use, and disclosure practices described in this Privacy Policy. If you do not agree to every provision of this Privacy Policy, you may not access the Website or use our services. Please also review our Website Terms of Use, which governs your use of the Website (available at www.wagonway.com), and the Terms of Service, which incorporates both the Website Terms of Use and this Privacy Policy into the collected terms and provisions that govern all aspects of our services (available at www.wagonway.com).

Any capitalized terms in this Privacy Policy that are not defined herein have the meanings described in the Terms of Service.

1. Information Collection

Information You Provide Us

When you use the Website, you may provide us with information about you, such as your name and contact information. When you register for an Account and become a Member (as governed by the Terms of Service), we may collect additional information related to your use of the Website such as: first name, last name, company name, email address, phone number, address, city, state, zip code, property or project information. We may aggregate this with information about other Members to help us improve and provide our services.

Some of the information collected from you may identify you (“**Personal Information**”), while some of the information does not, by itself, identify you (“**Anonymous Information**”). When Anonymous Information is associated or combined with Personal Information, such Anonymous Information will be considered Personal Information for purposes of this Privacy Policy.

You may also provide information to be published or displayed (hereinafter, “**posted**”), including User Contributions (as defined in the Website Terms of Use). Your User Contributions are posted at your own risk. Although we provide certain security measures (such as limiting access to certain pages or allowing you to set certain privacy settings), please be aware that no security measures are perfect or impenetrable. Additionally, we cannot control the actions of other Users of the

Website who may encounter your User Contributions. Therefore, we cannot and do not guarantee that your User Contributions will not be viewed by unintended or unauthorized persons.

Information Collected from Devices

We may also collect technical information about your connection to and use of the Website, such as your IP address, the type of device used to connect to the Website, your device operating system and version, your browser type, your network connection type, the webpage, if any, that referred you to the Website, and your behavior and activity on the Website.

When you access the Website, we may place small data files on your device that assign random, unique numbers to your device to enable us to recognize your device when you visit the Website. These data files may be browser cookies, flash cookies, web beacons, or other similar technologies and associated applications (collectively, “**Cookies**”). We may use Cookies to recognize your device, manage and store your settings and preferences, improve our services, offer targeted promotions to you, and collect and analyze information about your access to and use of the Website and related services.

Information Collected from Third Parties

At times we may also collect information about you from third parties, such as our business partners and service providers. We may collect Personal Information from third-party social networks, subject to their respective privacy policies and your privacy settings.

2. How We Use Information

We use information that we collect about you or that you provide to us, including any Personal Information:

- To present our Website and its contents to you.
- To provide technical or customer support for the Website.
- To provide you with information, products, or services that you request from us.
- To fulfill any other purpose for which you provide it.
- To provide you with notices about your Account, if applicable.
- To carry out our obligations and enforce our rights arising from the Terms of Service, including for billing and collection.
- To notify you about changes to our Website or any products or services we offer or provide through it.
- To allow you to participate in interactive features on our Website.
- To detect, prevent, or investigate actual or suspected misconduct, including fraud, hacking, intellectual property infringement, or any illegal activity.
- To verify the information provided is accurate and correct.
- In any other way we may describe when you provide the information.
- For any other purpose with your consent.

We may also use your information to contact you about our own and third-parties' goods and services that may be of interest to you. If you do not want us to use your information in this way, please click opt-out on any email correspondence to stop receiving these notifications.

We may use the information we have collected from you to enable us to display advertisements to our advertisers' target audiences. Even though we do not disclose your personal information

for these purposes without your consent, if you click on or otherwise interact with an advertisement, the advertiser may assume that you meet its target criteria.

3. How We Share Information

We may share Anonymous Information with third parties as described in this Privacy Policy, or for our commercial purposes. We do not share Personal Information with third parties except as described elsewhere in this Privacy Policy and as follows:

- To our subsidiaries and affiliates.
- If you request or authorize it.
- To complete a transaction or provide a service requested by you.
- To contractors or third-party service providers that provide services to support the Website, only to the extent necessary to provide such services, and only if such third parties are bound by contractual obligations to keep Personal Information confidential and use it only for the purposes for which we disclose it to them.
- To comply with Applicable Law.
- To comply with governmental and regulatory requests, court orders, subpoenas, or any other legal process.
- To protect our rights, property, and safety, or the rights, property, and safety of other Users.
- To enforce our rights arising from any contracts entered into between you and us, including the Terms of Service.
- If the disclosure is done as part of a purchase, transfer, or sale of our assets (e.g., in the event we are acquired by another organization, your Personal Information may be one of the transferred assets) or in the event of bankruptcy.

4. Your Choices About Your Information

We strive to provide you with choices regarding the personal information you provide to us. We have created mechanisms to provide you with the following control over your information:

Tracking Technologies and Advertising. You can set your browser to refuse all or some browser cookies, or to alert you when cookies are being sent. If you disable or refuse cookies, please note that some parts of this site may then be inaccessible or not function properly.

If you delete your User Contributions from the Website, copies of your User Contributions may remain viewable in cached and archived pages or might have been copied or stored by other Website Users.

6. Data Security
